### Annual programme for the teaching of English



In EYFS, we develop early readers and writers. We want to nurture a love of reading and literacy and work with parents to build up a strong home-school reading link. We want all our pupils to leave primary school with a strong voice to **“change the world!”**. It is here, in EYFS, that this voice begins to be developed.

#### **Some ways we support pupils to be successful:**

- We focus on telling stories, singing songs and listening to rhymes to build up a wide range of literary experiences.
- We provide time and space to develop pre-writing skills, leading to writing opportunities in lots of different settings.
- We teach fine and gross motor skills to ensure every pupil has the starting point they need to write.
- We place a high emphasis on developing vocabulary, with tiers of vocabulary around our classrooms for all pupils and staff to use.
- We encourage all pupils to ask questions and curious. This allows them to develop their communication skills and independence.
- We enable children to have involvement with their own literacy development.
